**FOOTBALL GAME: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 14**  
**WSMA STATE MARCHING BAND CHAMPIONSHIPS**  
**SATURDAY, OCTOBER 15**

**Friday, October 14**

- 5:30 p.m. Equipment truck will be loaded outside the band room – all percussionists please help!
- 6:00 p.m. Help unload the truck @ WLC
- 6:15 p.m. Arrive at WLC in band t-shirt and athletic shorts. Unload truck. (Battery: unpack your drums BEFORE changing into uniform.) Change into full uniform except for your hat/plume. Store street shoes and clothes in your uniform bag, not your drum/instrument cases.
- 6:30 p.m. Be in the stands in full uniform; the band sits together in the section at the very south end of the bleachers.
- 6:40 p.m. Pre-game music of pep tunes, school song and Star Spangled Banner
- 7:00 p.m. Game begins, we play the school song for touchdowns
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Midway through the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, you will be dismissed by sections to get your hat and plume. Once you receive these items, please proceed immediately to the north end of the stadium where we will meet on the track to prepare for halftime.
- Halftime Perform full show
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Put away hat/plume. Hang up bibs and jacket properly. Put gauntlets and shoes away properly. Hang up your uniform properly and check it in with uniform moms. Help load equipment truck. You are then free to sit with your friends or leave. Truck will remain loaded for our trip to Whitewater.

**Game Time:** Remember, we are in performance attire and attitude throughout the game. **No eating or drinking while in uniform** (with the exception of water). Certainly, proper Christian sports conduct is expected of all band members. If you need to leave the stands to use the restroom, please check out with Mrs. Bailey or another staff member.

**Music:** Please bring your lyre and flip folder.

**Saturday, October 15**

- 11:30 a.m. Arrive at school; unload rehearsal equipment from truck
- Noon – 2 FINAL REHEARSAL AND SHOW PREPARATION FOR OUR 2011 SEASON! Come prepared to work hard in order that you perform at your very best!
- 2:00 p.m. Reload truck – change in band t-shirt and athletic shorts – load buses; Bring a light snack with you to eat on the bus.
- 2:30 p.m. Depart for Whitewater
- 3:30 p.m. Arrive Whitewater; use restroom, unload truck, get into ½ uniform (bring uniform burrito), music, visual warm-ups
- 4:45 p.m. Warm-up/spot check on practice field
- 5:15 p.m. Leave for gate
- 5:30 p.m. Gate time
- 5:45 p.m. Performance Time**
- 6:00 p.m. Go to Kachel Fieldhouse for pictures by Jolesch Photography;
- 6:15 p.m. Change out of uniform (except DM/Guard Captain), load equipment truck, put away instruments, return to stadium. ENJOY the rest of the day watching your fellow band students from all over the state in the superb marching venue of Perkins Stadium. Temperature is expected to be in the 50's during the day with a low of 43. Bring WARM clothing, blankets, etc. You MUST remain on the UW-Whitewater campus unless you are with your parents.
- 9:30 p.m. Class A/AAA Awards Ceremony**
- 10:00 p.m. Return to buses

10:15 p.m. Depart for WLHS

11:15 p.m. Approximate time of return; ALL help unload truck!!!

**Attendance:** Attendance is required at ALL rehearsals/events. If an emergency arises, please notify Mrs. Bailey immediately – cell phone 414.690.5717.

**Uniform:** We will change into uniforms at Whitewater (get on the bus dressed in t-shirt and athletic shorts; you may put sweats or jeans over your shirts). Other uniform reminders:

- You must wear SHORTS under your uniform
- Bring tall, solid-colored black socks (**at least calf-length!!!**)
- Bring black gloves.
- Long hair (longer than collar length) must be put up under your hat. This is for girls and guys.
- No earrings are to be worn.
- Guard, Flutes, Clarinets: No neon colored nail polish.
- Check for any loose buttons or other items on your uniform. If something needs to be repaired, notify Mrs. Williams or Mrs. Bohlmann as soon as possible.

**Transportation:** We will travel by school bus to Whitewater and all students must ride the bus to the competition. You may go home with your parents after the show. Remember they must sign you out with a chaperone in order for you to leave.
