

## **WLHS MARCHING BAND INFO SHEET**

### **VETERAN'S DAY PARADE: SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 5**

- 9:00 a.m. Arrive at WLHS wearing a band t-shirt and athletic shorts; **MAKE SURE YOU HAVE YOUR SHOES AND GLOVES.** Change into uniform, get your hat (no plume). Get on bus in uniform with your instrument, gloves, gauntlets and hat.
- 9:30 a.m. Leave for parade staging area.
- 11:00 a.m. Parade steps off**
- 1 – 2 p.m. Approximate time of return (depending on our position within the parade)

**Attendance:** Attendance is required at ALL events. If an emergency arises, please notify Mrs. Bailey immediately – cell phone 414.690.5717.

**Uniform:** We will travel to the parade site in uniform including hats (but not plumes). All uniform regulations are in effect:

- You must wear SHORTS under your uniform
- You must wear tall, solid-colored black socks (**at least calf-length!!!**)
- You must wear black gloves.
- Long hair (longer than collar length) must be put up under your hat. This is for girls and guys.
- No earrings are to be worn.
- Guard, Flutes, Clarinets: No neon colored nail polish.
- Check for any loose buttons or other items on your uniform. If something needs to be repaired, notify Mrs. Williams or Mrs. Bohlmann as soon as possible.

**Transportation:** We will travel by school bus to and from the parade site. These buses were generously provided for us by the WLHS Student Council – please thank them. All students must return to WLHS on the bus following the parade in order to turn in their uniform.
